


PanCareSurPass

is an EU-funded project looking at how to more widely implement the SurPass to improve survivorship care for survivors of childhood and adolescent cancer in Europe.



What will PanCareSurPass do?

Conduct a pre-implementation study by consulting stakeholders through online surveys, open space meetings and literature surveys to develop a practical implementation strategy.

Develop, test and launch the digital SurPass Version 2.0 with translations into local languages of the participating countries.

Conduct an implementation study looking at survivor empowerment and satisfaction with the digital tool.

Develop a prediction model to help healthcare decision makers to assess suitability and costs of using the digital SurPass in the local context.

Address challenges faced when scaling up digital health solutions, including issues related to care, ethics, legal, social, economic requirements and interoperability and IT issues.

Implement the digital SurPass V2.0 in clinics in Austria, Belgium, Germany, Italy, Lithuania and Spain.

Develop materials to support implementation of the digital Surpass in new countries across Europe in the future.

Widely disseminate and communicate our research to survivors and their families, healthcare professionals, decision makers and policy makers.
